### **Milk Bag Mats**

Many thanks to everyone who has worked so hard on the Milk Bag Mat Project. We have accomplished much in a short time. Many have collected bags, come to workshops, shared the word with others as to how to make them and other groups have been growing out of these efforts. We took on the project to make the lives of other people in poor countries more comfortable. This past week I received news from Canadian Food for Children, the agency that sends the mats abroad, that there have been some significant **unintended outcomes** of this project that they have utilized for some time. Some livestock are eating them. Some babies have ingested the plastic. They are flammable.

I have asked my contact at Canadian Food for Children to send me the letter they have prepared to explain why they have discontinued the project. At the same time, I asked them what their greatest need is right now. I was advised that they are in great need of pneumonia vests and that they have a pattern they will send us if we are interested in providing them. I will share this information with you after it arrives.

Fr Don and I have discussed this development. Given the concerns noted, we will not look for another agency to send the mats, as the problems would likely be the same. We will discontinue the project at this time and see if we may be of service in another way that will bless others and give us the opportunity to be a blessing.
