Daniel is a student in our Sunday School. He and his family started attending St. George's last spring. Daniel is in a wheelchair, so when he comes to church he stays on the lower level of the building, as it is too awkward for him to start the service in church and then get him moved all the way outside to go downstairs to Sunday School with the other Children.

We need the congregation's help as "**Buddies for Daniel**". Each Sunday, Daniel's buddy-for-the-day will hang out with him in the Sunday School area from his arrival about 9:45, to about 10:15 am when the Sunday School teachers and other children come downstairs for the Sunday School program. This will allow Daniel's parents to get his brothers settled, and allow them to go upstairs for the start of the service.

Daniel is easy to get along with, and he likes people to read stories to him, and to play cars with him. Daniel's family and the Sunday School leaders will work with Daniel's buddies to help you get to know him and to answer any questions you have.
