### **Update - Choir Gowns**

Oct. 16th

As we have previously indicated, our senior choir started talking about acquiring new choir gowns roughly 4 years ago. COVID then stymied the discussion and the initiative. We indicated recently that we have moved forward in ordering 21 new gowns, which we hope will arrive prior to Christmas and perhaps prior to Advent.

The anticipated total cost is \$4410, of which \$3500 will be covered by funds set aside some years ago. I am very much encouraged to report that in just the last several weeks, more than \$750 has come forward to help pay for the difference. We very much appreciate the response we have already had from the parish and are very hopeful and optimistic that additional

offerings will come forward to help us pay for the new gowns.
